



Bishop Fenwick School is fortunate to be able to offer tuition assistance to our families who qualify both financially and academically. In addition to the required financial information listed below, it is required that any child receiving tuition assistance be in good academic and character standing throughout the year. The student may not fail more than two classes per quarter and must strive to be a positive student representative of Bishop Fenwick School at all times. Failure to follow the above requirements may jeopardize financial assistance.

Parent/Guardian requirements to request financial aid are as follows:

- a.** Complete and submit all requirements for the Diocese of Columbus FACTS Tuition Aid application by March 15th.
- b.** Complete the Bishop Fenwick School Tuition Aid application by March 15th
- c.** Complete a Participating Parish Scholarship application, if applicable

Once the above items are received, the family's financial information and the student's academic and character will be reviewed by the Executive Director of Bishop Fenwick School. A decision will be communicated to the parent/guardian when the review is complete.
